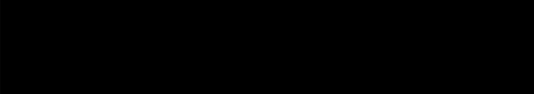

1. On 11 July 1951 in Abadan a leftist anti-National Front counter-demonstration disrupted a public welcoming demonstration for the visiting Dr. Mozaffar Baghai. Eighteen leftists were arrested for causing the clash.
2. After investigating the possibility of organizing branches of his Iranian National Workers' Party in Khuzistan, Dr. Baghai departed without making progress in his plan. 1
3. [REDACTED] Prime Minister Mohammad Mossadeq ordered Dr. Baghai not to establish branches of his Party in Khuzistan on the ground that the inevitable clashes between such groups and Tudeh Front groups would jeopardize public security and cause disorder in Khuzistan at this critical time. 2
