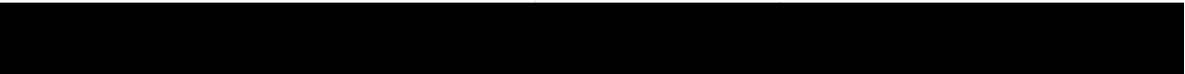

In the course of a welcoming talk made before a small group of new Tudeh members on 26 December 1952, Hoseyn Lankerani² stated that the Tudeh Party favored the elimination of the monarchy and the creation of a republican government in Iran. Lankerani added that "recently" Ayatollah Kashani had expressed his "consent" to the Party view and "is particularly kind to us. We hope to reach our goal with his aid."
