

- 1. According to source, it is "generally agreed" that the date of the contemplated Tudeh "revolution" has been postponed (presumably until conditions are more favorable) because the Tudeh Party currently is in a position to exploit the widespread popular approval of Soviet support of Iran in the Security Council and because the Soviet Union may offer economic aid to Iran.
- 2. Although source does not know the details of the plans or extent of the "revolution," he is of the opinion that the Tudeh Party would test its strength by precipitating unusual violence. If the Iranian Security Forces should be either unprepared for an amable to control such violence, it is possible that a plan to "strike further" would be implemented by the Tudeho
